 Assembled design team and initiated design for the South Carson Complete Streets Project

October 2018



 Conducted 2 public meetings (September 2016 & March 2017) to select preferred street cross sections:



- Majority of businesses were extremely positive about the project





Traffic Reductions




- South of Fairview
 - > 40% reduction since opening of Phase 2B of I-580 in 2017
- Fifth to Stewart
 - 33% reduction with opening of Phase 2A of I-580 in 2009 and 30% reduction since opening of Phase 2B of I-580 in 2017
- Traffic demand modeling-Existing and 2040
- Optimize signal timing



Stewart Street Roundabout



- Design highlights:
 - LOS A for all legs and all times except westbound PM peak 2040 scenario.
 - Decreased O&M costs
 - Improved safety- Significant anticipated crash reduction from 3/year to 1.6/year (Societal cost savings of \$2.8M)
 - Single lane roundabout = easier to navigate
 - Provides gateway to the City

Preferred Option- Single lane roundabout with northbound and southbound bypasses







Project Funding

Total Project Funding: \$18,696,000

Redevelopment = \$205,000 Infrastructure = \$1,040,000 TIGER = \$7,570,000 State = \$6,251,000 Stormwater = \$2,900,000 Water = \$450,000 Sewer = \$280,000

Project Cost Breakdown:

Planning/Design (6%) = \$1,098,000 Permitting/Utilities (0.5%) = \$91,000 Construction Mgmt./Inspection/Testing (3%) = \$550,000 Construction (90.5%) = \$16,957,000


Schedule
